

Peel-Off Projects

Colour Dimension Autumn Card

- Step 1:
 Cut a wavy line
 Step 2:
 Stick on flower designs
 Step 3:
 Turn over the flower-part and cut through the wavy line again on the back
 Step 4:
 Stick on the leaf veins



Peel-Off leaves 0425 orange, red, black, white
 Peel-Off flowers 0400 orange, red, black, white
 Card-making cardboard: orange, red, black, white
 Peel-Off marker, black
 Black fineliner
 Basic materials

Method:

Cut a 14.8 x 21 cm rectangle from the white cardstock, score down the middle, and fold the card. Cut a 9.8 x 14.3 cm rectangle from black cardboard and stick this onto the card. Cut rectangles measuring 13.7 x 9.6 cm from the red and orange card, place them on top of each other and cut through in a wavy line. Take an orange part and a red part (the other halves can be used for a second card) and line them up with each other on the cutting board. Tip: stick both pieces to the cutting board with a tiny drop of photograph adhesive, and allow to dry; then they won't slide about. Stick the flower designs over the wavy line, carefully turn the whole thing over (remember the glue), cut through the line again, and stick onto the black background with the front facing upwards and with 1 mm space in between the two parts. Work with the stickers in contrasting colours on the coloured card: i.e. red designs on the orange card, and orange designs on the red card. Apply the black leaf veins to the leaves and draw decorative lines using the marker. Stick the little circles onto the background. Use the fineliner to draw little lines along the white edges of the card and draw a frame on the coloured part.
