

## Peel-Off Projects

### Anniversary – Hennie Zellenrath

**Step 1:**

Colour the edges of the card using the gold ink pad.

**Step 2:**

Lift the little frame from the sticker sheet using moistened fingertips, and lay it upside down, i.e. with the sticky side facing upwards. Carefully lay the cardboard on top.

**Step 3:**

Cut the silhouette to size and stick into the little frame.

**Step 4:**

Colour the words, letters and numbers using the black marker.



- Black Peel-Off 0331
- Gold Peel-Off 1621 1635 1668
- Peel-Off markers
- Black cardstock
- Basic Grey: Infuse paper pad
- Ink pads: gold and black
- Ribbon
- Hole-punching pliers, 3 mm
- Strass stones
- 0.8 mm foam tape
- Basic materials

**Method:**

Cut a piece of black cardstock to 10.5 x 30 cm. Score a line 7.5cm from the edge of both short sides, and fold the card. Colour the edges using the gold ink pad. Cut 9.5 x 14 cm of scrapbook paper, colour the edges using the black ink pad and affix to the middle section. Affix the fleur-de-lis design in each corner. Fold the card into shape, cut 2 rectangles 7 x 9.8 cm, colour the edges using the black ink pad and affix to the front flaps. Lift the photograph frames from the sticker sheet using moistened fingertips, and lay them upside down with the sticky side facing upwards. Carefully lay the scrapbook paper on top. Cut the silhouettes to size and stick them into the little frames. Cut out the frames, affix strips of foam tape to the backs, and stick them onto the flaps. Decorate them with Strass stones. Punch holes and thread the ribbon through the holes. Colour the words, letters and numbers using the black marker and affix as desired. Stick on little flowers in the corners.
