

Peel-Off Projects

Christmas Card – Hennie Zellenrath

Step 1:

Colour the whole picture using the black Peel-Off marker.

Step 2:

Lift the design from the sheet using moistened fingertips, and lay it upside down with the sticky side facing upwards. Carefully lay the cardboard on top.

Step 3:

Lift a few of the design remainders (left behind on the sticker sheet) using the tip of the knife, and reposition in the picture.

Step 4:

Colour in the design using the Peel-Off markers.

Peel-Off markers

Red, yellow and grey scrapbook paper

Black card-making cardboard

Skin-coloured card-making cardboard

White gel pen

0.8 mm foam tape

Double sided sticky tape

Basic materials

Method:

Cut the card shape from the black cardboard using the template. Stick the red scrapbook paper onto the front and cut to size. Stick the cut-to-size grey scrapbook paper to the back.

Sticker design: two different techniques are used in making this card: colouring in/colouring using the permanent markers and replacing the design remainders (the parts that are left behind on the sticker sheet once the design has been used).

Colour the whole depiction of the singers using the black marker. Stick the sticker onto the skin-coloured cardboard (see tip) and colour in the desired areas using markers. Lift up the design remainders using the tip of the utility knife and position them back in the design

(men's jackets and hats). Cut out the image.

Colour the contour lines of the sign board using the black marker, moisten the back of the hook design and stick the board onto the yellow scrapbook paper, then cut out the shape. Stick the whole thing to the upper left corner of the card. Colour the contour lines of the music stand, stick it onto the background and colour in the open areas using the markers. Stick on the singers using foam tape. Colour the lettering and the scatter designs and stick them onto the card. Add dots (snowflakes) using the gel pen. Stick the card together using double-sided sticky tape.
