

## Peel-Off Projects

### Crossword puzzle – Hennie Zellenrath

Step 1:

Score the line onto the card.

Step 2:

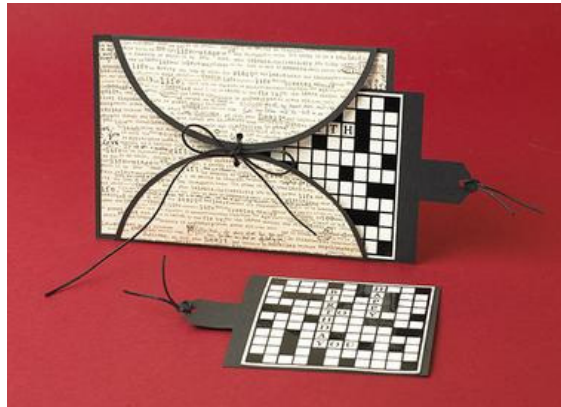
Remove the crossword puzzle from the backing, lay it upside down on the cutting board with the sticky side facing upwards, and place the neutral-coloured cardboard on top.

Step 3:

Stick the letters onto the crossword puzzle with the aid of the tip of the utility knife.

Step 4:

Cut the label.

Card-making cardboard: in black and a neutral colour

Ink pads: black

Scrapbook paper

Hole-punching pliers

Waxed cord: black

Photograph adhesive

Embossing pen

Basic materials

Method:

Cut the card from black card-making cardboard according to the template, score the lines and fold the card. Cut the scrapbook paper as shown on the template, colour the edges using the ink pad and affix to the inside and outside of the card. Punch holes and thread the cord through the holes.

Cut out the labels from black card in accordance with the template and punch the holes. Stick the crossword puzzle onto the neutral-coloured cardboard, cut out leaving a rim around it, and colour the edges using the ink pad. Add a message using the supplied letters. Stick the puzzles onto the labels and attach the cords to the labels.

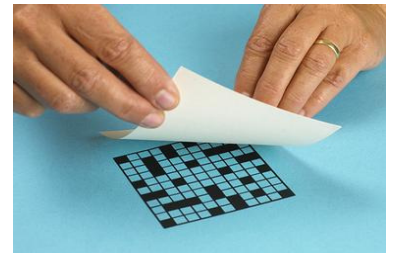
Tip:

Moisten your fingertips and carefully remove the design from the Peel-Off. Place it upside down on the cutting board with the sticky side facing upwards. If necessary, correct the position using moistened fingertips and then carefully place the blue cardboard on top. Push down gently and turn the card the right way up.

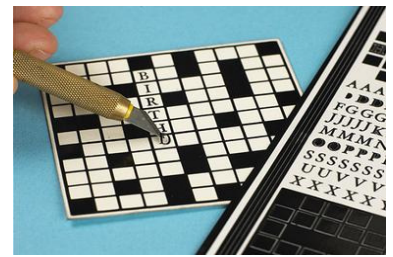
