

## Peel-Off Projects

### Wedding - Photo

1. Cut out the cream-coloured square, and accentuate the edges using the ink pad.
2. Paste on the Peel-Offs and colour them in.
3. Make a copy of an old photograph, and punch or cut out a circular section.
4. Punch or cut out a black circle and paste the photograph onto it.

#### Requisites:

Peel-Off gold 1900

Copy of an old photograph

Cardboard base suitable for greeting cards - cream and black

Markers

Ink pad: brown

Basic materials

Circle punch in 2 different sizes or a circle cutter

#### Working method:

Accentuate all the edges using the ink pad. Paste the Peel-Off patterns onto the cream-coloured square and colour it in with markers. Cut out a rectangle of 13.5 x 27 cm from the cream-coloured cardboard, score the middle, and fold it. Cut out a square of 12.5 x 12.5 cm from the black cardboard and a 10 cm square from the cream-coloured cardboard, and paste them onto each other. Using a punch or cutter, punch or cut out a 7.5 cm circle from black cardboard, and punch or cut out a 6.4 cm circle from the copy of the photograph. Paste them onto each other and into the middle of the passe-partout.
