

## Peel-Off Projects

### Safari – Giraffe Card - Hennie Zellenrath

**Step 1:**

Stick the giraffe design onto the rainbow paper (see tip).

**Step 2:**

Rub a strip of Magic Tape onto the edge of the embroidery stitches.

**Step 3:**

Transfer the strip of Magic Tape (complete with embroidery stitches) onto the card.

**Step 4:**

Stick on the inner card behind the opening in the card using foam tape

Magic Tape

Rainbow cardboard or rainbow paper reinforced with double-sided adhesive film

White cardstock

Black cardstock

Black ink pads

2 mm foam tape

Basic materials

**Method:**

If no rainbow card is available, you can try the following solution:

Stick the rainbow paper onto the white cardstock using double-sided adhesive film.

Using the embroidery stitches: remove the backing sheet of the Peel-Off so that only the embroidery stitches are visible. Cut a thin strip of Magic Tape (instruction on the reverse of the Magic Tape and on the website) and rub this onto the embroidery stitch line, for example using the back of a pair of scissors. Pull the strip away and check that the designs have stuck to it. If not, scratch them on using your fingernails. Lay the strip onto the background and run with your fingers. The designs will remain on the card.

Colour the edges of the rainbow paper using the black ink pad.

Card with giraffes: Cut a 10.5 x 30 cm rectangle from the black cardstock, score down the middle and cut a 6 x 9.3 cm opening in the middle. Cut a passe-partout from the rainbow paper, 0.5 cm smaller in the middle and at the sides. Decorate this with embroidery stitches, designs and lettering. Cut a 10 x 14.5 cm inner card. Stick the giraffe design onto rainbow paper, cut it out and stick it onto the inner card. Stick on the inner card behind the opening in the card using foam tape
