

Peel-Off Projects

Tennis Card - Hennie Zellenrath

Step 1:

Stick the design onto the skin-coloured card. Tip: remove the design from the sticker sheet with moistened fingertips and lay it upside down on the cutting board with the sticky side facing upwards. Carefully lay the cardboard on top.

Step 2:

Scratch away the little remains from the tennis racquet with the tip of the knife.

Step 3:

Colour in the figures using the yellow marker and the white soufflé pen.

Step 4:

Stick pieces of foam tape onto the back of the figure



Black tennis Peel-Off 0366

- Black cardstock
- Skin-coloured card
- Basic Grey paper pad, Recess
- Peel-Off markers
- White soufflé pen
- Black ink pad
- 1 mm foam tape
- Basic materials

Method:

Stick the black sticker design onto the skin-coloured card. Colour in the various parts with the markers and the white soufflé pen. "Scratch" away the tiny remains from the tennis racquet with the tip of the knife. Cut out the finished design and colour the cut edges using the black ink pad. Stick the design onto the card using 1 mm foam tape. The cards are cut from black cardstock and scrapbook paper.

Card:

Cut a horizontal (landscape) piece of card measuring 29.7 x 10.5 cm from the black cardstock. Score a 7.7 cm wide strip on the left-hand side and a 7.2 cm wide strip on the right hand side. Fold the card into shape. Stick scrapbook paper onto the strips and the inside of the card, cut 0.3 cm smaller.

Stick a tennis ball in the corners and fill these in using the soufflé pen. Use the fineliner to draw a thin line along all sides of the card. Stick the figures onto the card using 1 mm foam tape
