

## Peel-Off Projects

### Black & White Card - Hennie Zellenrath

Step 1:

Stick the large white flowers half onto the black passe-partout.

Step 2:

Turn the black passe-partout over and cut off the protruding parts.

Step 3:

Lay the passe-partout with the cut-off white flowers on top of the matching black flowers on the sticker sheet, and cut them exactly along the edge.

Step 4:

Stick on the matching black design, lining it up with the edge of the white flower design.

Sticking on the sticker designs:

Remove the backing of the sticker sheet. The designs can now be seen more clearly. Stick the white flowers half onto the black passe-partout. Turn the whole thing over, and cut off the protruding parts carefully along the edge of the passe-partout. Now lay the sticker-covered card exactly on top of the black flower designs still on the sticker sheet, and cut them exactly along the edge. Do the same with the little hearts of the flowers. Now stick the sticker-covered black card onto the white background of the card, remove the cut-through flowers from the sticker sheet and stick the appropriate parts from the black sticker design onto the white card, lining them up exactly with the cut-through white flower designs.

Method for card:

Cut a 13.5 x 27 cm rectangle from black cardboard, score down the middle, and fold the card. Cut a 13 x 13 cm square from the white cardboard, round off the corners using the corner punch and stick onto the card. Cut a black square passe-partout measuring 8 cm and round off the corners with the corner punch. Stick the designs onto the parts of the card, following the general instructions, and connect them with doodles drawn with the white gel pen on the black card and the black fineliner on the white card.
